CURRENT HYGIENE CONCEPT



Concept for the realization of the Interland Cup from 21.10.21 – 23.10.21 in Darmstadt, Germany.

All athletes, coaches, accompanying persons, judges and officials are obligated to implement the specifications of the implementation concept. The requests to implement the official requirements must be followed.

Non-compliance will inevitably lead to expulsion from the sports grounds/rink.

The following regulations have been established to reduce the risk of infection due to the COVID19 pandemic, considering the legal requirements:

- There is a daily rapid test obligation for all athletes, accompanying persons, coaches, judges, and officials, unless they have a vaccination certificate (14 days after booster vaccination) or recovery status. These are valid 24 hours. Means: Thus, the negative result of the antigen rapid test will be checked at the entrances.
- To get to the sports ground/rink there will be a nonofficial- testcenter WITHOUT CERTIFICATE right in front of the rink.

ATTENTION: this rapid test is only to get into the rink with no official certificate. Please consider that you get the result 15 mins after the test.

If you need a certificated rapid test or PCR-test for your flight or your hotel, please book an appointment at one of the testcenter described in the “Information about testing possibilities”. Please ask at your hotel and at your airline what kind of test you will need.

Assistance for this appointment booking can be requested at the entrances from the volunteers.

- The wearing of a medical mask is obligatory for everyone during the entire time spent in the venue. Exception: During the warm-up as well as on the rink itself, the mask obligation is cancelled for the athletes.
- A maximum of 4 accompanying persons per athlete should be allowed as spectators for the competition (not for the training) plus the accredited coaches/team manager/Delegates
- The venue will be regularly aired by opening the windows.



- We ask for proper hand hygiene and adherence to cough and sneeze etiquette. Disinfection dispensers will be provided in the various areas for this purpose.
- We ask all attendees to keep a minimum distance of 1.5 m and to respect the different areas for athletes/coaches, adjudicators and for accompanying persons.
- The entry and exit will be at the side. The entry will be separated by nations to avoid long queues. It will be signposted.
- The chairs will be placed with a distance.
- The changing rooms should use by maximum 6 skaters at the same time. Should be better to style and dress before entering the sports ground.
- Please try to stay only for your own competition and medal ceremony. If the sports ground is getting to full, only the competitors which will start next are allowed to stay with their coaches and nearest family members.
- Please respect the minimum distance when queuing here as well.

What do I need for entry?

- At the entrance EVERYBODY must register DAILY with our regional QR-Code (with QR-Code-Reader or Camera). There you must register your first name, family name, address, city, email, phone number and your duration of stay. If you have not the possibility to register via mobile, you must write down your data at the entrance in a list. The volunteers at the entrance will help you.
- Every Competitor, official, delegate, coach, team manager will get an Access card at the entrance. There you must prove your status (Vaccinated, Convalescent or Tested)
- Every Spectator must also prove their status (Vaccinated, Convalescent or Tested) and will get an entry bracelet

The organizer is to be informed immediately at the registration office in case of a suspected case of a COVID-19 disease and the visit of the event is prohibited with immediate effect.

Nobody is allowed to enter the sports ground if:

- 1.) a contact with a person infected with the Corona virus has existed or exists or if 14 days have not yet passed since the last contact, or
- 2.) the typical symptoms of a COVID-19 infection exist, such as smell and taste disturbances, fever, cough, or sore throat.

ATTENTION: please stay informed by yourself for entry into Germany. There could be daily changes.

There are only special requirements when you are from a high-risk area.

INFORMATIONS ABOUT TESTING POSSIBILITIES

TESTING:

If you are vaccinated or recovered, you only must show your national vaccination certificate or the prove that you are recovered (original or digital) at the entrance. You don't need a test.

If you are **NOT** vaccinated or recovered, you must show a negative test result at the entrance.

There will be possibilities for rapid tests **WITHOUT CERTIFICATION right** in front of the rink from 08:00 AM till 14:00 PM from Thursday, 21.10.21 till Saturday, 23.10.21

- When you have done a certificated rapid test or PCR on Wednesday (20.10.2021) in your hometown, you don't need a test on Thursday to enter the rink. Just show the proof at the entrance from Wednesday (original or digital)
- When you have done a certificated rapid test or PCR on Thursday (21.10.2021) in your hometown, you don't need a test on Friday to enter the rink. Just show the proof at the entrance from Thursday (original or digital)
- Children under 6 Years don't need to show a negative test

ATTENTION: the rapid test in front of the rink is ONLY FOR THE ENTRANCE into the sports ground. It is NOT a certificated test for your hotel or journey.

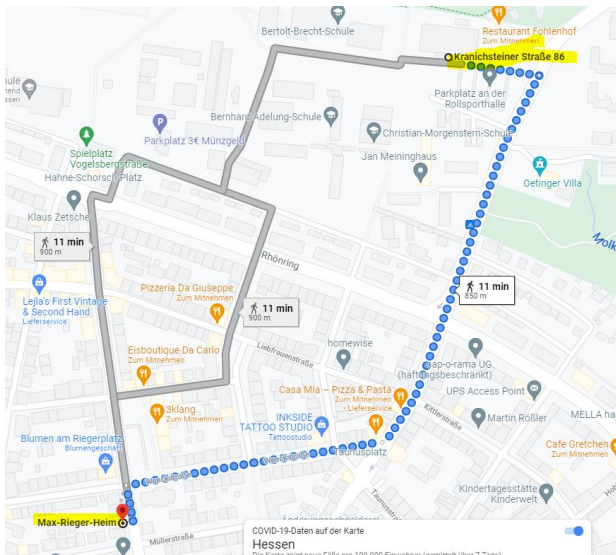
